

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System Requirements

Systems	Requirements
Connectivity	Both the Point-of-sale (POS) system and EFTPOS Terminal need to be connected to the same Local Area Network. (This is usually setup by the Abacus technician during POS install).
POS Version	6.22.4.16111and above
POS Operating System	Windows
Integration Type	SPI

Pairing the POS to the EFTPOS Terminal - *POS configuration* (1 of 3)





