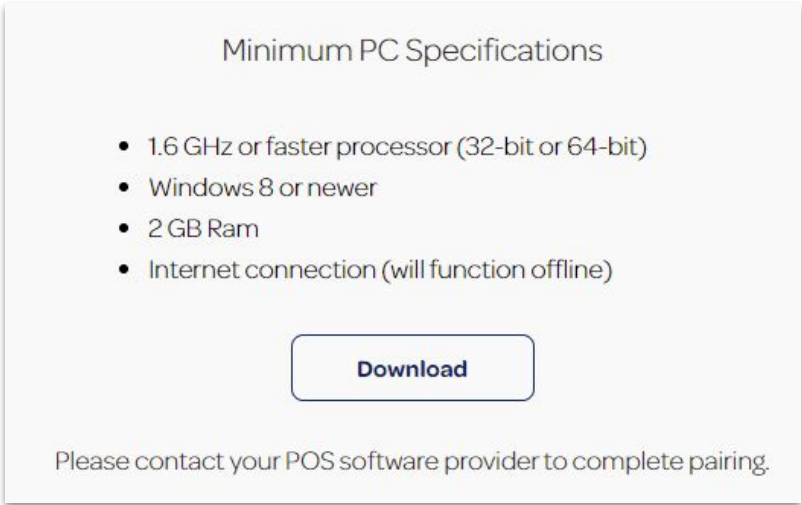
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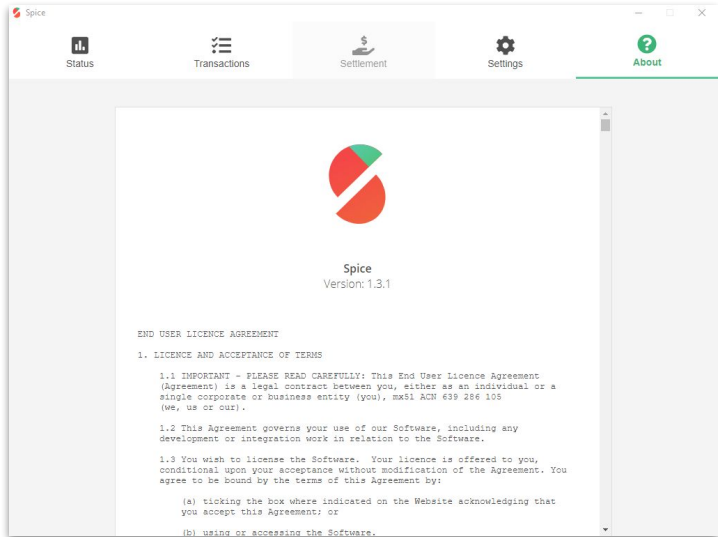
System Requirements

Systems	Requirements
Connectivity	Both the Point-of-sale (POS) system and EFTPOS Terminal need to be connected to the same Local Area Network
POS Version	6.76 and above
POS Operating System	Windows 10 and above
Integration Type	SPICE

Pairing the POS to the EFTPOS Terminal - *Setting up Spice* (1 of 7)

1. Download Spice https://spice.integration.mspenv.io/latest.exe <i>* Please see your POS provider for enabling Spice integration within the POS. 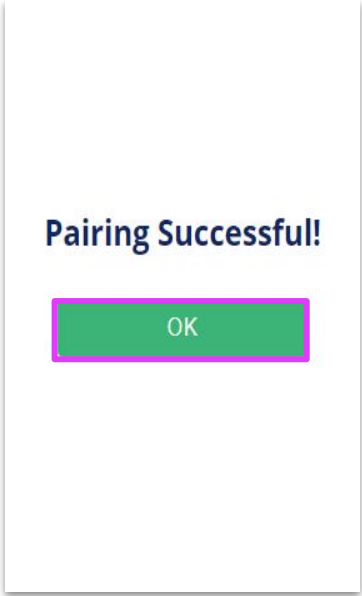
