




System Requirements

Systems	Requirements
Connectivity	Both the Point-of-sale (POS) system and EFTPOS Terminal need to be connected to the same Local Area Network
POS Version	V37.1R and above
POS Operating System	Windows 10 and above
Integration Type	SPI Java

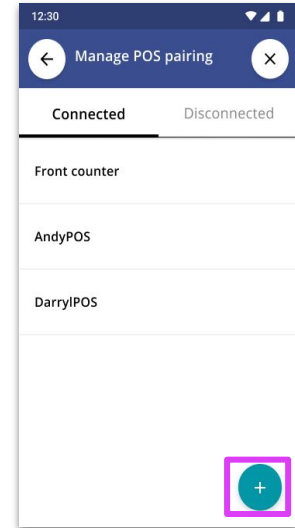
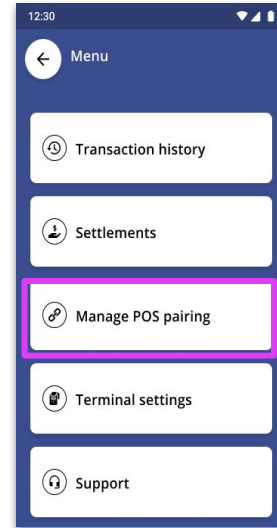
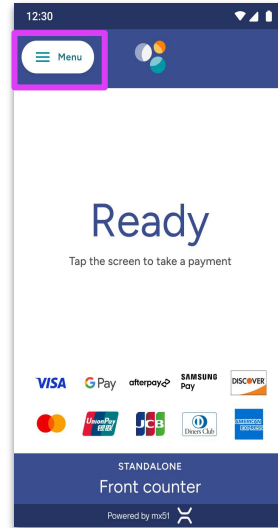
6. On the EFTPOS terminal, Select Menu



9. Enter in the **POS ID** and **EFTPOS IP Address** and save.
10. Select **Pair** in MiPOS

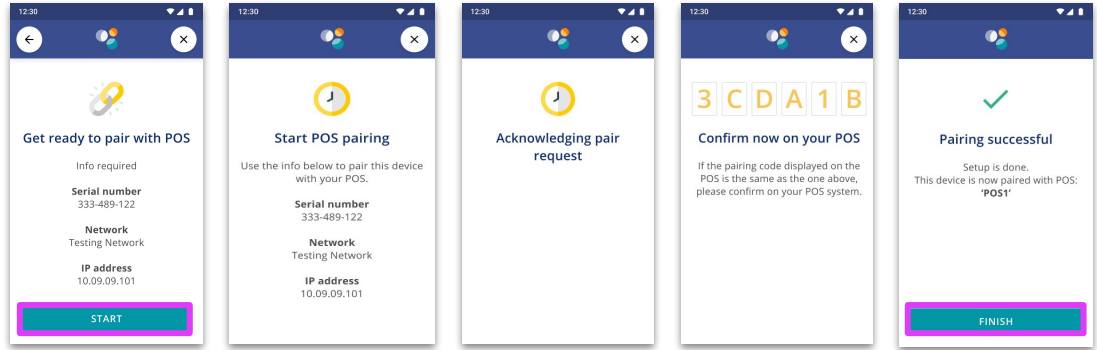

 - Select **START**
 - Ensure the code displayed matches what is displayed on POS and select **YES**
 - Select **FINISH**

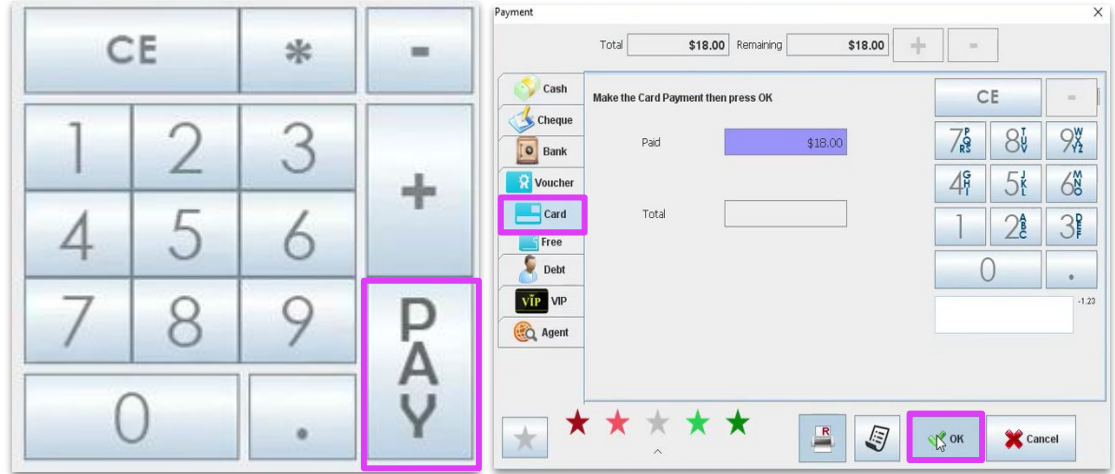
Perform a Test Purchase Transaction - (1 of 2)

To perform a test [Purchase Transaction](#) to ensure that the integrated solution is working:


1. Select the item and select [Pay](#)
